<p>Before Reading:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Introductory statement• Introduce new vocabulary/tricky words• Let's take a picture walk...• What do you notice about...?• What do you see?• What do you think it means?• What do you predict?	<p>Print Concepts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Where is the title, author/illustrator's name, front/back cover, spine, title page?• Where do you start reading?• Which way do you go?• Point to the beginning/end of a word.• Point to a space in between the words.
<p>Self-Monitoring</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reread the sentence.• Check the beginning, middle, or end of the word. Does the sound you made match that letter?• What else can you try?• How can you figure it out?	<p>Structure</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Does that sound right?• Is that how we say it?• How do we say that?
<p>Visual</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Does it look right?• Read it with your finger.• Does it match?• Frame the word• Do you know a word that looks like this?• Cover up the ending• Find a part you know	<p>Meaning</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Does that make sense?• Check the picture/Does it match?• Think about the story• Read again and think about what makes sense.
<p>After Reading</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Retell the story<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tell me about...<ul style="list-style-type: none">• What did it mean when....?• What did they author want to tell us?<ul style="list-style-type: none">• What questions do you have?<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Why do you think....?
