# <u>Staffing Update</u>

As you will be aware recently I was appointed Head Teacher at Uphall. I am looking forward to continuing the improvement work we started last session and working closely with pupils, staff and families to ensure all pupils reach their full potential. Mrs Galek has now started her maternity leave and in her absence Mrs Sutherland has taken on the role of acting principal teacher while continuing to provide support for learning within the school. This session two of our class teachers will be supporting our improvement work with development roles in addition to their class teaching commitment. Mrs Hunter will be supporting improvement within numeracy and Miss Rodger within literacy. We are also working with Education Scotland this session as part of our ongoing development work within teaching and learning.

# Health and Safety - STAFF CAR PARK/DROP OFF & PICK UP

Parents, Carers and pupils are not permitted to enter or use the staff car park. Please keep our children safe and ensure you adhere to West Lothian Council policy. Despite reminding all our families about this important safety notice there is still a minority of families who do not think this safety rule applies to them.

We are still witnessing an increasing number of cars parking irresponsibly across resident access drives and over the zigzag lines which is dangerous and illegal. Please don't be a selfish driver and think of the safety of everyone .<u>Please park</u> <u>sensibly and safely.</u>

# <u>Attendance</u>

If your child will not be attending school for any reason please ensure you contact the school office before 9am if possible. The school office operates an answer machine system when the school is closed which you can also leave a message on. Safe arrival procedures in line with West Lothian Council policy will be initiated if we do not hear from you.

# Safety Measures

Please ensure you adhere to 2 metre social distancing and any one way systems when collecting or dropping off your child. We would also ask that children arrive as close to school starting time as possible to avoid crowds while waiting to enter and especially as the weather is getting colder.

# <u>Illness</u>

As the weather is changing and there may be more colds and other winter bugs we would ask that parents and carers continue to be vigilant about any Covid 19 symptoms and follow the test and protect protocols.

If your child is unwell with a winter related illness they should not attend school until they are well and should be 48 hours clear of sickness and diarrhoea.
