### Addition

Activities:

2. Write out your number bonds in your jotters eg  $10+0=10$ ,  $9+1=10$  etc
3. ICT - Topmarks - Hit the Button - Number Bonds


**CHALLENGE** Use the bonds for learning addition with 10s and 100s.

So  $1+9=10$     $10 + 90 =100$     $100+900=1000$   
 $2+8=10$     $20+80 =100$     $200+800=1000$   
 $3+7=10$     $30+70=100$     $300+700=1000$

### Counting in 10s

Activities:

2. Take the 100 square from the P1/2 Pack and using the wipe clean pen, start at 10 and circle counting up in 10s.
3. Count down from 100 in 0 in 10s. Challenge yourself by starting at a higher number eg 250.
