Weight

Make a mobile to help you find out about weight and balance.

- Cut out some shapes from cardboard (you could use a cereal box).
- Decorate both sides of the shapes.
- Ask an adult to help you make a hole in the top of each shape and thread a piece of string through it
- Attach a length of string to the middle of a long stick.
- Tie the shapes in different places. Once you have done this you will have to slide them along the stick until the mobile balances. You may also have to adjust the lengths of the strings.
