Listening game: IDENTIFYING FAMILIAR SOUNDS

What's making that sound? **What's in my basket?**
Place in a basket/box a variety of objects that make a distinctive sound e.g. bell, whistle, clock, zip, jangling keys, pebbles to drop, scissors and card/paper to cut, paper to scrunch/tear, packet of crisps to shake, water in a jug to pour, egg beater to whisk the liquid, sharpening a pencil, bouncing a ball, a squeaky toy, a book to turn pages/slam closed, hammer and nail, spoon/cup to stir. Hide the basket behind a screen. The children have to identify what you are using to make the sound. Show them the object and repeat making the sound as feedback.
