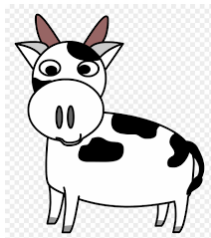

A few activities to try

Who can use our playdough recipe to make a tall beanstalk of their own? Do you think it will reach the giants castle in the sky? Remember to take pictures of your creations.

Talk about the story with your adult maybe you could get creative drawing, painting or collaging a picture of your favourite part of the story or favourite character.



Why not have try at planting your own magic beans and see what you can grow? Do you think it will turn out to be a beanstalk?

To do this you will need

Empty jar

2 or 3 broad beans

Kitchen roll

Scissors

Water

What you need to do

Cut the kitchen roll so it fit snugly around your empty jar

Place the beans between the paper

Pour a little water into the bottom of the jar and let the paper soak it up

Keep the paper moist and watch over the next few days the beans sprouting roots and shoots

Fee, fie, foe, fum! There is a lot of measuring to be done. Can you find things that are longer than the giants footsteps?
