





Outdoor Snow Glow Activities!

- Build a 3 sphere high snowman/snowwoman or a snowdog.
- Make a snowteacher! Can you make your teacher out of snow?
 - Build an outdoor shelter e.g. igloo/den/snow fort!
- Write winter themed words in the snow. Could you use your footprints.
 This may be trickier than you think, you'll need good balance!
 - Go sledging with family or friends.
- Measure and record how deep the snow is using a measuring device e.g.
 ruler, tape measure.
- Snow hunt! While you are out playing in the snow go on a walk and see
 if you can spot the following and take pictures of them: fresh snow,
 footprints, snowflakes, snowy trees, frozen water, icicles and melting
 snow.
 - Have fun in the snow like the Gentoo penguins at Edinburgh Zoo do! https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=RCzR28md3nU How many snowflakes can you catch in 1 minute? How many can your friends or family members catch?
- Measure and record how deep the snow is using a non-standard unit of measure e.g. the snow is one mars bar deep
 - Make snow angels.
- How many snowballs can you make in 1 minute? Race somebody to see
 who can make the most in the minute!
 - Play hide and seek in the snow with family or friends.
 - Take photographs of icicles. What is the longest icicle you can find?
- Time how long it takes for a bowl/bucket to fill with snow/rain/sleet?
- Film an outdoor David Attenborough style winter weather documentary.







Indoor Snow Glow Activities!

- Make a snowball and bring it indoors. Put it in a bowl and time how long
 it takes for the entire snowball to melt.
 - What is the longest word that you can make using the word:

Abominable Snowman

Remember you can only use each letter once.

- Make a paper snowflake chain for your window.
- Play a board game with someone in your house e.g. chess, monopoly, hangman, charades. Think about what skills (communication, numeracy, thinking etc) you are using to play this game?
- Create your own board game!
- Help an adult do a household chore e.g. hanging up washing, making the bed, washing dishes. Did you learn how to do something new?
- With an adult practise your culinary skills! Could you help prepare a meal or bake a sweet treat? Write down your recipe to share!
- Can you work within a budget? Make a shopping list for your family's next week shop.
- Find puzzles that you can share with your peers when you return to school, make sure you can solve them yourself!
- Write/type an imaginative story about being lost in the woods. Who do you meet? What do you hear/see/feel/taste/touch? What happens in the woods? How does it end?
- Write a diary entry about a previous Christmas/New Year.
- Invent a new winter sport. What are the rules? What equipment is needed? Is it a team game or individual? Can you try out your game?
- Create a detailed drawing/painting of a snow globe showing a winter scene.
- Create/draw/paint a winter scene.
- Make you and your family a hot chocolate and drink them whilst sharing a conversation.

- Go online and play Sumdog, remember you can play gainst your classmates! Your teachers will be keeping an eye on the scores!
- Create a fact file/power point/poster on your current class topic.
- Play the alphabet game with somebody or write them down. Can you come up with a band/movie/food/sport beginning with each letter of the alphabet A-Z. Good luck!

- Cuddle up with a good book. Where is your reading corner?
- Pretend to be a weather reporter and film a weather report on today's weather. Think about your voice, outfit, what would make it fun to watch. Are there any safety tips you could give viewers. If you can't film it then could you write/type a script for it?
- Time yourself and write down as many prefixes as you can in 60 seconds.
 Now try it with your opposite hand; how many can you write now?
- Create a wordsearch for a family member, friend or pupil to solve when you return to class.
- Design your own school bag. What would it be called? What features would it have e.g. wireless phone charging, cup holder?
- Science: Using a balloon fill it with water and freeze them to make Ice Spheres.
- Keep active and your heart rate up in your own way! You could help shovel your drive with an adult, use Sworkit App or complete some bootcamp workout exercises such as sit ups, squats and the plank!
- Science: Using the link you will find fun at home science experiments.
 Choose one to complete and write about it or film it.
