

# Primary 1 Newsletter

August – October 2019

Primary 1 has had an exciting time joining Windyknowe Primary School! We hope that this newsletter will give you a flavour of the learning taking place in our first term.



## Welcome to Primary 1

All of the children have settled into school well. The children start each day by registering and learning through play for the first 20 minutes. The children are becoming more independent, looking after their own property and getting to know their way around their classrooms and school. Remember to provide one snack for playtime and water for during the day.

## Numeracy & Maths

We will be learning to recognise numbers to 10, count objects accurately, order numbers within 10 and beyond for some. We will use the language before, after, more and less. We will learn to write the numbers correctly through Number Zoo stories and rhymes. We will also be learning to find different ways to sort objects and to record our findings.



## Child-led Learning Through Play

In the afternoons the children will be learning about the topic 'All about Me' through play activities and short discussions. The children will be encouraged to lead the learning by sharing their ideas and investigating problems, working independently and with others. All areas of the curriculum will be explored during this time, providing exploration and challenge opportunities.

## Additional Teachers

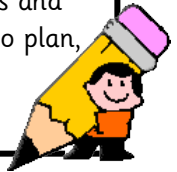
Miss Hendrie will be taking all P1 classes for RME and Maths and Problem Solving. We will be learning about pattern and shape, using the children's ideas for practical activities to explore and investigate.



## Literacy & English

We will be learning our sounds using the Jolly Phonics, Active Literacy, Vowel House and Colourful Consonants schemes. We will learn to recognise them through stories, rhymes, songs, and actions. We will practise writing and listening for the sounds through writing tasks and lots of other fun games and practical activities that we can choose from.

We will also be focussing on listening to instructions and taking turns to talk in groups. We will be starting to plan, discuss and tell our own stories and we will initially be focussing on picture detail.



## Health & Wellbeing

We will be learning about our school's vision and values and how we can be a good member of our class and school. We will also be finding out what we can do to keep ourselves safe at school, at home and in the street.



## Additional Information

We will have P.E. every Thursday and Friday. Children should come to school wearing their PE kit wherever possible. This can be black joggers/leggings and appropriate school polo shirts (no football colours). All belongings must be clearly labelled with your child's name.
