<p>Aim: To write, say and identify letter sounds</p> <p>Cut A4 paper into 8. Write a lowercase letter and its capital letter partner in each space. Refer to your letter formation sheets in your pack if needed.</p> <p>Use these cards to play a game of bingo!</p> <p>Each player gets a selection of cards and an adult/family member calls out a letter. As the letters are called out, children look to see if they have that letter and if they do, the letter is placed in a pile in the middle.
