<p><b>LI: to write a persuasive text</b></p> <p>The 4 key parts a persuasive text are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Title</li><li>2. Statement of Position (opening sentence describing the purpose of the writing)</li><li>3. Series of Arguments (at least 3 paragraphs explaining thoughts of the writer)</li><li>4. Concluding Statement (final sentence stating the writers opinion)</li></ol> <p>Have a think back to yesterday's poem <b>"The Green Man"</b>. Have another read of it on Oxford Owls if you can.</p> <p><b>Should the boy go to the alien's planet with him?</b></p> <p><b>Think of at least 2 reasons for yes and at least 2 reasons for no.</b></p> <p>*If you cannot access Oxford Owls, think about the planet you designed yourself.</p>	<p><b>Write a persuasive text</b> telling the reader the reasons why the boy should go to the planet and the reasons why he should not go to the planet.</p> <p><u>Remember to explain your reasons.</u> Think about stretching your sentences and adding extra sentences with details.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Think about including '<u>powerful vocabulary</u>'.</p> <p>*If you are writing about your own planet, give at least 2 reasons that you should travel there and at least 2 reasons why you shouldn't.</p>	<p><b>WAGOLL (What A Good One Looks Like)</b> This is an example created by an adult – We would use this to show the children how to create their piece of writing.</p> <p><u>Should I travel to the planet Zog?</u></p> <p>I think there are lots of reasons why people might want to visit the planet Zog.</p> <p>Firstly, it has some <u>incredible</u> fruit that is <u>only available</u> on the planet. It comes from the <u>giant</u> zoog trees and is <u>bright blue</u> inside. Secondly, the planet Zog has <u>enormous</u> water slides made of strawberry milkshake. You could drink <u>as much as you want</u>.</p> <p>However, the planet Zog has some <u>dangerous</u> animals on it. The liffen is a bird with <u>sharp</u> claws and a <u>long, pointy</u> beak that likes to swim in the strawberry milkshake.</p> <p>The planet Zog is also <u>very far</u> from the planet Earth. It would take <u>5 weeks</u> to get there.</p> <p>Overall, I think people should visit the planet Zog to taste the wonderful fruit.</p>
