<p>LI: to spell words correctly</p> <p>Dictation - An adult or sibling will need to help you with this job. Ask someone to make a sentence using your spelling words and say it out loud to you. You then write the sentence down thinking about your spelling patterns.</p> <p><u>Some sentence ideas:</u></p> <p>Cherries - The <u>fly</u> flew <u>high</u> to the <u>light</u>. Bananas - The <u>doe</u> <u>bought</u> a new <u>toe</u>. Apples - The <u>heroes</u> <u>fought</u> their <u>foes</u> with <u>tomatoes</u>.</p> <p>These sentences can be silly but the important part is the spelling!</p> <p>Check over your words to see if you managed to spell them correctly.</p> <p><u>Mrs Smyth's group</u></p> <p>Create a spelling word jigsaw with your 'y'</p>	<p>LI: to create actions to a rhyme and perform</p> <p>Have a read of the daffodil rhyme.</p> <p>Can you create some actions to go along with it?</p> <p>Perform your rhyme to someone in your house.</p> <p>*If you want, you could ask someone to record you and send us a video to the school email address!</p>	<p>LI: to listen for information</p> <p>Follow the link to watch this episode of 'come outside'.
