



Make a thank you card for somebody in your family. Can you think of 2 things to thank them for?



Make a dark den under a table using duvet covers or throws. Invent a password. Think of ways to make it more comfortable inside.



Plan an indoor picnic. Make a list of what you will need and help to make the food.



Plan a birthday party for a favourite toy. It could be anything from just a pretend tea party to a big party with music, balloons, treats and party games (Musical Statues, Pass The Parcel, Simon Says etc).



Make a road map on your bedroom floor with masking tape and then use Lego, bricks or things that you would recycle to make a town. Draw a map of your town or take an aerial photograph.



Make a puppet theatre from a large box. Open it up and cut out a window in the opposite side. Put it on a table. Use toys as puppets. Make up a story. Make tickets and a poster for your show. Alternatively use the box as a TV and pretend to be a weather reporter.



Collect some of your recycling and use it to create a model, a new toy or a game.



Design a new form of transport -google 'unusual transport images'



Collect small objects from around your house or from outside (E.g. pegs, toothpicks, screws, curtain rings, cotton buds, pebbles, twigs, leaves) Use these to create your own picture or pattern. Can you make a symmetrical pattern or an animal picture? Google 'transient art' for ideas.
