<p>Aim: To investigate place value in groups of 10s</p> <p>Play Place Value Toss game (This can be played indoors or outdoors)</p> <p>Line up two boxes vertically about a ruler's width away from each other. The first box is the 1s and the second box is the 10s. Make sure the 10s box is the furthest away one.</p> <p>Find 10 soft items to throw (e.g. pieces of Lego or scrunched paper/ tinfoil). Throw the items into either of the boxes and then work out the number you have created!</p> <p>For example 3 items in the 10s box and 7 in the 1s box = 37</p> <p><u>Extra challenge:</u> https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/place-value-basketball</p>	<p>Aim: To know the months of the year</p> <p>Click on the link below and listen to/sing along to the 'months of the year' song.</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Fe9bnYRzFvk</p> <p>Collect photos of your family taken throughout the year. The photos should be clearly linked to a particular time of year by the clothing worn, special occasions, the weather or the state of growth of plants. Discuss each of the photos sort them or place them into order of the different months.
