<p>Aim: To write a set of instructions.</p> <p>Discuss with an adult the different steps that are required to grow a plant. An example is on the next page.</p> <p>Now draw a picture for each step, you can decide how many steps you want (around 2 – 5 steps). Once you have completed your pictures, have a go at writing a set of instructions explaining each step.</p> <p>Remember finger spaces between words, letters on the lines and full stops. At this stage your child will be spelling using the sounds they hear and the sounds they know. This is fine. For example, ‘water’ may be spelled like ‘wotr.’</p> <p><u>Extra Challenges:</u> Can you read your instructions aloud to someone?</p> <p>Draw another picture of what you think your plant may look like once it is fully grown.</p>	<p>Aim: To read words with the bl, cl, gl and sl sounds.</p> <p>Read the spelling words by sounding them out. Underlined letters make one sound together. Choose 3 words to write down and draw. The words are on the next page in a larger font.</p> <p><u>Extra Challenge:</u> Read the trickier words on the challenge list.</p>	<p>Aim: To listen to and identify rhyming words.</p> <p>Listen to each of the words below. Think of 3 rhyming words that sounds like them. Try and write these other words in your jotter. E.g. dog - log, frog, jog</p> <p>cat man pen</p> <p><u>Extra challenge:</u> Read this sentence to someone and see if they can spot the rhyming words or ask an adult to read the sentence to you and listen out for the rhyming words!</p> <p>I tap on the cap and the map.</p>
