(Feel free to give her recipe a go with the help of an adult!)</p>	<p>WAGOLL (What A Good One Looks Like)</p> <p><u>Baking Shortbread</u></p> <p>Goal To bake shortbread.</p> <p>Materials You will need:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 200g unsalted butter• 100g caster sugar, plus extra for sprinkling• 300g plain flour, sifted, plus extra for dusting• Bowl• Wooden spoon• Baking tray• Rolling pin <p>Steps</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Heat oven 170C2. Put the flour, butter and sugar into a mixing bowl.



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		<ol style="list-style-type: none">3. Use your hands to rub the ingredients until the mixture looks like breadcrumbs.4. squeeze until it comes together as a dough.5. Use a rolling pin to roll out the dough.6. Cut the dough into fingers and place on a baking tray.7. Use a fork to create imprints, then sprinkle with the remaining caster sugar.8. Bake for 15-20 mins until golden brown. Remove the shortbread fingers from the oven and leave to cool.
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
