<p><u>Aim:</u> To use what I have learnt about tens and units to count money</p> <p>Watch this BBC cartoon. BBC bitesize KS1 money class clips - counting by grouping into tens and units https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zp8dmp3/resources/1 –</p> <p>What coin could you use instead of ten 1p coins? How could you make 45p with 10p coins and 1p coins? Remember that 45 is made of 40 and 5 or 4 tens and 5 units. Use real coins to show 45p or draw them.</p> <p><u>Extra challenge:</u> Can you use 10p coins and 1p coins to make other 2-digit numbers?</p>	<p><u>Aim:</u> To identify a cuboid and a cylinder. To describe 3D shapes using mathematical words.</p> <p>Play this cuboid or cylinder game.</p> <p>Spot cuboids around your house. A cereal box is a cuboid shape. Spot cylinders around your house. A tin of beans is a cylinder shape. Ask an adult to describe one of these shapes using two clues. Can you say what shape they are describing? Repeat using other clues.</p> <p>Cuboid: I have 6 faces. I have some rectangle faces. All my faces are flat. I have no curved faces. I have 4 corners. I have 12 straight edges. I can't roll.</p> <p>Cylinder: I have 3 faces. I have 2 flat circle faces. I have one curved face. I have no corners. I have 2 curved edges. I can roll.</p> <p><u>Extra challenge:</u> Can you say some clues for your adult to guess?</p>
