<p><b>LI: to write a procedure</b></p> <p><b><u>A procedure gives the reader instructions about how to make or do something.</u></b></p> <p>3 key parts to a procedure are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Goal</li><li>2. Materials</li><li>3. Steps</li></ol> <p>Today you can <b>choose</b> what procedure topic you would like to do. Here are some ideas but feel free to pick something different.</p> <p><b><u>How to get dressed</u></b> <b><u>How to ride bike</u></b> <b><u>How to get ready for a rainy/sunny day</u></b> <b><u>How to cook/bake something</u></b> <b><u>How to make slime</u></b></p> <p>Think of the steps involved. What materials do you need? How do you do it properly? Is there a correct order?</p>	<p><b>Write your procedure thinking about the 3 key parts.</b></p> <p>Each sentence will start with an <u>action verb</u>. Make sure you get everything in the correct order.</p> <p>Miss Foote has done a WAGOLL about how to make a cup of tea.</p>	<p><b>WAGOLL (What A Good One Looks Like)</b></p> <p><u>How to make a cup of tea</u></p> <p><b>Goal</b> To make a cup of tea</p> <p><b>Materials</b> You will need:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Mug</li><li>• Kettle</li><li>• Water</li><li>• Tea bag</li><li>• Spoon</li><li>• Milk (optional)</li></ul> <p><b>Steps</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Fill the kettle.</li><li>2. Boil the kettle using the on switch.</li><li>3. Put your teabag in the mug.</li><li>4. Pour in the boiling water leaving some</li></ol>



		<p>space for milk.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>5. Add some milk if you want.</li><li>6. Take the teabag out using the spoon.</li></ol>
