<p>Aim: To write a set of instructions.</p> <p>Choose a household task that you either complete on your own or help someone else complete. For example, this could be making your own breakfast cereal in the morning.</p> <p>Discuss with an adult the different steps that are required to make your breakfast.</p> <p>Now draw a picture for each step, you can decide how many steps you want (around 2 – 5 steps). Once you have completed your pictures, have a go at writing a set of instructions explaining each step. An example of this can be found below.</p> <p>It helps to imagine that you are explaining it to someone that has never completed this task before!</p> <p>Remember finger spaces between words, letters on the lines and full stops. At this stage your child will be spelling using the sounds they hear and the sounds they know. This is fine. For example, cereal may be spelled as ‘seerial’ or bowl may be spelled as ‘bol’.</p> <p><u>Extra Challenge:</u> Can you read your instructions aloud to someone?</p>	<p>Aim: To read words with the tw sound.</p> <p>Read the spelling words by sounding them out. Underlined letters make one sound together. These can be found in larger font below.</p> <p>twig twist <u>tweet</u> twitch twins twirl <u>tweed</u></p> <p>Choose 3 words to write down and draw. The words are on the next page in a larger font.</p> <p><u>Extra Challenge:</u> Read the trickier words on the challenge list below.</p>	<p>Aim: To identify rhyming words.</p> <p>Listen to each of the words below. Think of 3 rhyming words that sounds like them. Try and write these other words in your jotter. E.g. dog - log, frog, jog</p> <p>rug bun dig</p> <p><u>Extra challenge:</u> Read this sentence to someone and see if they can spot the rhyming words or ask an adult to read the sentence to you and listen out for the rhyming words!</p> <p>The men went to see the hen in the big pen.</p>
