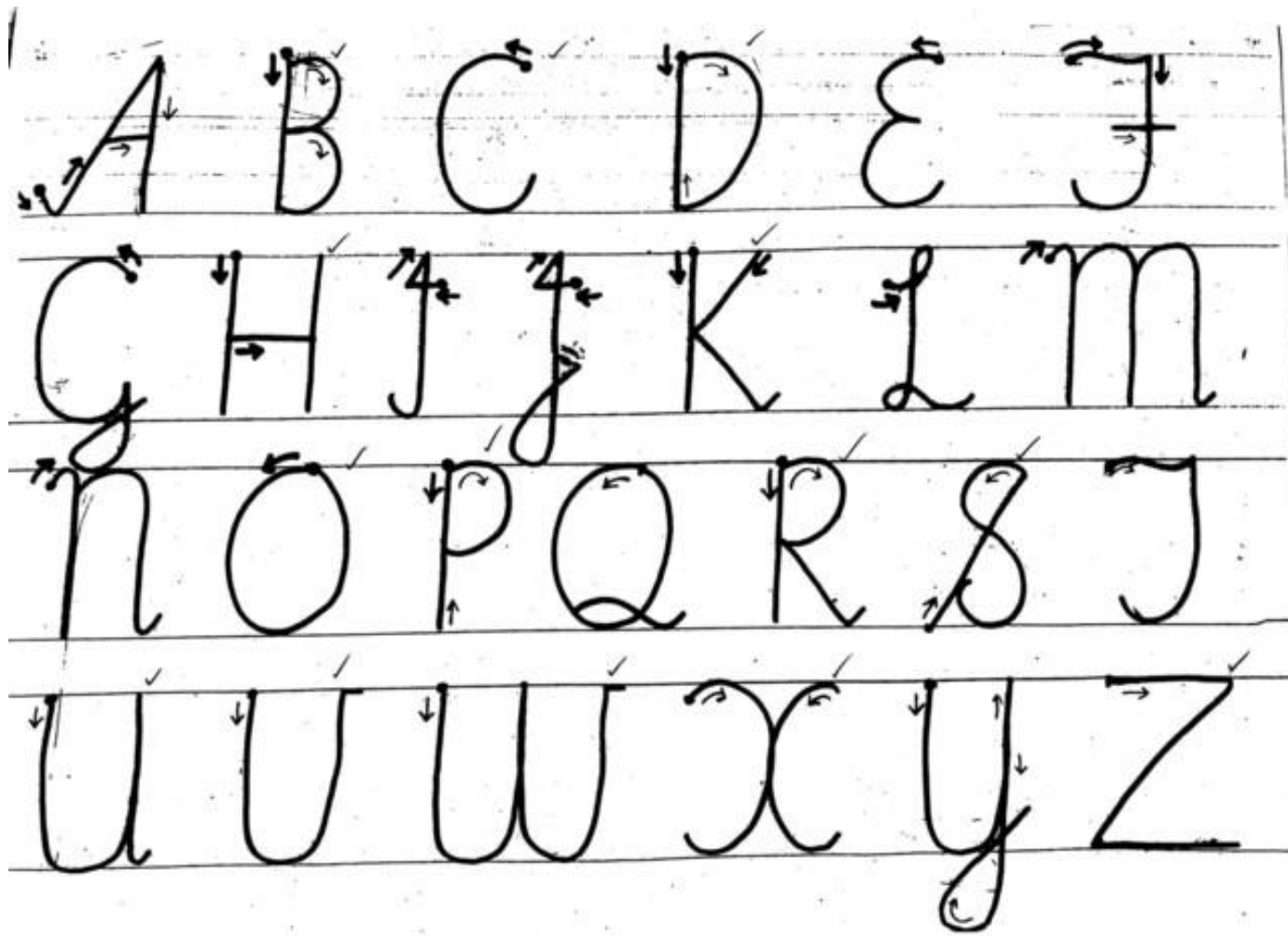

Handwriting Task 1	Reading Task 2	Talking Task 3
<p>Aim: To write, say and identify capital letters.</p> <p>Please use the Windyknowe uppercase letter formation worksheet in your pack to help. A copy of this can also be found below.</p> <p>Have a go at writing these capital letters. Adults may wish to dictate the words beside each letter below. Use a lined page to practise positioning them correctly on the lines.</p> <p>M – Start near the top of the line with a small curve and draw a straight line to the bottom. Now on the same line follow the line back up and curve it around and down to the bottom. Repeat the last step again.</p> <p>N – Start near the top of the line with a small curve and draw a straight line to the bottom. Now on the same line follow the line back up and curve it around and down to the bottom.</p> <p>X – Start near the top of the line and draw a curved line to the bottom like a back to front C, then lift your pencil and draw another C shaped curve making sure both of the lines meet in the middle like their backs are touching.</p> <p><u>Extra challenge</u> – Can you think of a person’s name or a place that begins with today’s capital letters?</p>	<p>Aim: To read for information.</p> <p>Have a go at reading the following. Ask an adult to read it with you if you need some help. The text is on the next page in a larger font. Some of you will also be able to complete this task on paper from your most recent home learning pack.</p> <p>‘Fish lay eggs in the sea. Birds lay eggs in a nest. Crocodiles lay eggs in mud. Toads lay eggs in a pond. Moths lay eggs on a leaf. Bees lay eggs in wax hexagons.’</p> <p>Answer true or false to the following statements (this can be done orally and you don’t need to write the answers):</p> <p>Toads lay eggs in mud.                  Fish lay eggs in the sea.                  Moth lay eggs in wax hexagons.                  Birds lay eggs in a nest.                  Bees lay eggs on a leaf.</p> <p><u>Extra Challenge:</u> Write the answers to the questions in sentences in your jotter. Copy the correct spelling of words from the text.</p>	<p>Aim: To use your voice in different ways.</p> <p>Choose a nursery rhyme that you are familiar with. For example, ‘Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star’ or ‘Jack and Jill.’</p> <p>Now have a go at saying this nursery rhyme in lots of different voices.</p> <p>Here are some ideas of different voices you can use: loud, quiet, robot, as if you are speaking to an audience or as if you are speaking to a little baby.</p>
