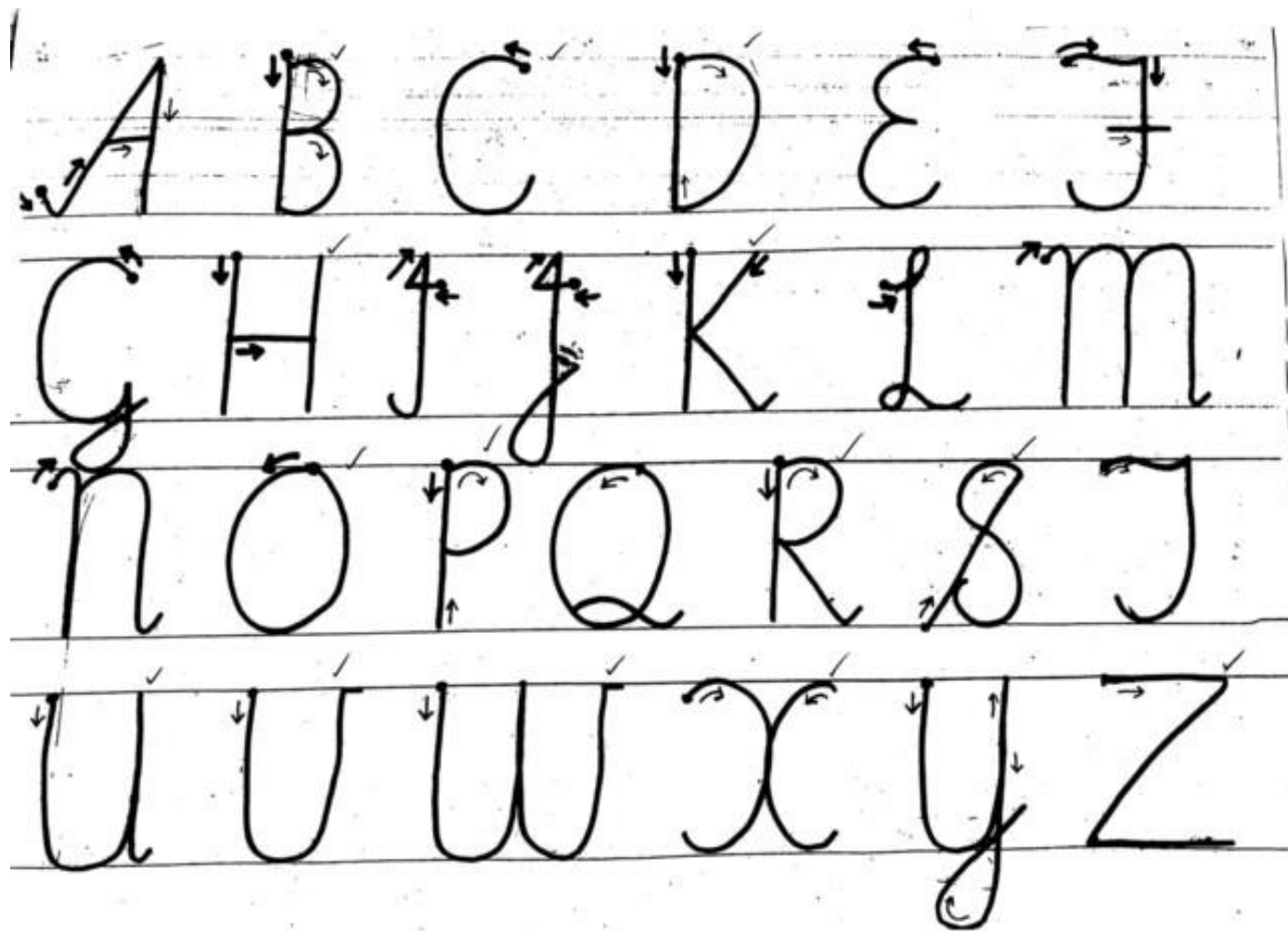

<p>Aim: To write, say and identify capital letters.</p> <p>Please use the Windyknowe uppercase letter formation worksheet in your pack to help. A copy of this can also be found below.</p> <p>Have a go at writing these capital letters. Adults may wish to dictate the words beside each letter below. Use a lined page to practise positioning them correctly on the lines.</p> <p>Y – Start at the top of the line and draw a straight line to the bottom and curve up to the top again like the U. Now on the same line follow the line back down and curve it around under the paper line and back up like the end step of the J.</p> <p>G – Start near the top of the line and draw a line curving around like the C. Now on the same line draw the line down and curve it around under the paper line like the J and the Y.</p> <p><u>Extra challenge</u> – Can you think of a film or TV programme that begins with today’s capital letters?</p>	<p>Aim: To read for information.</p> <p>Have a go at reading the following. Ask an adult to read it with you if you need some help. The text is on the next page in a larger font.</p> <p>“A garden is a good place to find mini-beasts. If you look at flowering plants you may see honey bees and bumble bees. Bees are very important to a garden because they move pollen which helps plants to grow seeds and fruit”.</p> <p>Answer true or false to the following statements (this can be done orally and you don’t need to write the answers):</p> <p>A garden is a good place to brush your teeth. Bees move pollen. Honey bees can be found near fish. Plants grow seeds and fruit.</p> <p><u>Extra Challenge:</u> Write the answers to the questions in sentences in your jotter. Copy the correct spelling of words from the text.</p>	<p>Aim: To talk clearly to share ideas and feelings</p> <p>Choose one or more of the following questions and discuss with a family member.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you had a superpower, what would it be? Why? • Do you prefer ice cream or chocolate cake? Why? • Would you rather be very hot or very cold? Why? • Would you rather live underwater or in outer space? Why? • Would you rather travel by boat or by train? Why? <p><u>Extra challenge:</u> Can you think of similar questions to ask a family member?</p>
