How would you tell someone to make it from start to finish?</p> <p>Write a short set of instructions on how to make your favourite sandwich. Your first instruction would be to wash your hands but what would you do next?</p> <p>If this is a little tricky then draw the process step by step and label your drawings with a few words.</p> <p>Remember finger spaces between words, letters on the lines and full stops.
