<u>Literacy – Grammar</u>

L.I. To identify verbs and adverbs

Play verbs and adverbs charades with a member of your household. If there are more than three of you in your home, you may want to split into teams to make your game a bit more competitive!

Instructions

First, choose a verb and act it out for a member of your household. Once the verb has been guessed, then add an adverb.

E.g. clean frantically

Act out the verb 'clean' first of all. Once the guesser has answered this, then act out 'cleaning frantically'.

One point for guessing the correct verb, and two points for guessing the correct adverb.

<u>Art</u>

L.I. To follow instructions carefully

Have a go at making origami monster bookmarks!



You will need:

You will need a sheet of paper (preferably origami paper), scissors and decorations and glue to make the monster or any other creature your heart desires. The decorations can be made from paper.


Instructions:

Start by folding the paper in half .

Fold the left and right corner to the centre point. Cut off the excess part and cut through the middle so that you get two triangles.

Unfold them – you've gotten yourself two squares that will soon turn into two monster bookmarks!


Fold the square in half – you'll get a rectangle – fold in half again and you'll get a smaller square. Unfold it.



As you've unfolded the small square you'll see 4 small squares inside the unfolded square – cut one out as shown on the picture bellow.

Now cut the adjacent two squares from the one you've cut out as shown on the picture (diagonally through the square).

Fold the little triangles inward – apply some glue to the inner one and you're done!



All that's left to do is to cut some eyes, tongues, teeth, tentacles, horns... And glue them onto your monster!
