Can you make a sensible guess as to what the numbers on the houses on either side will be? You will need to use your knowledge of numbers up to one hundred for this. You may also need to think about odd and even numbers and counting forwards or backwards in twos. Delivery drivers and postal workers will use these number skills all the time.
