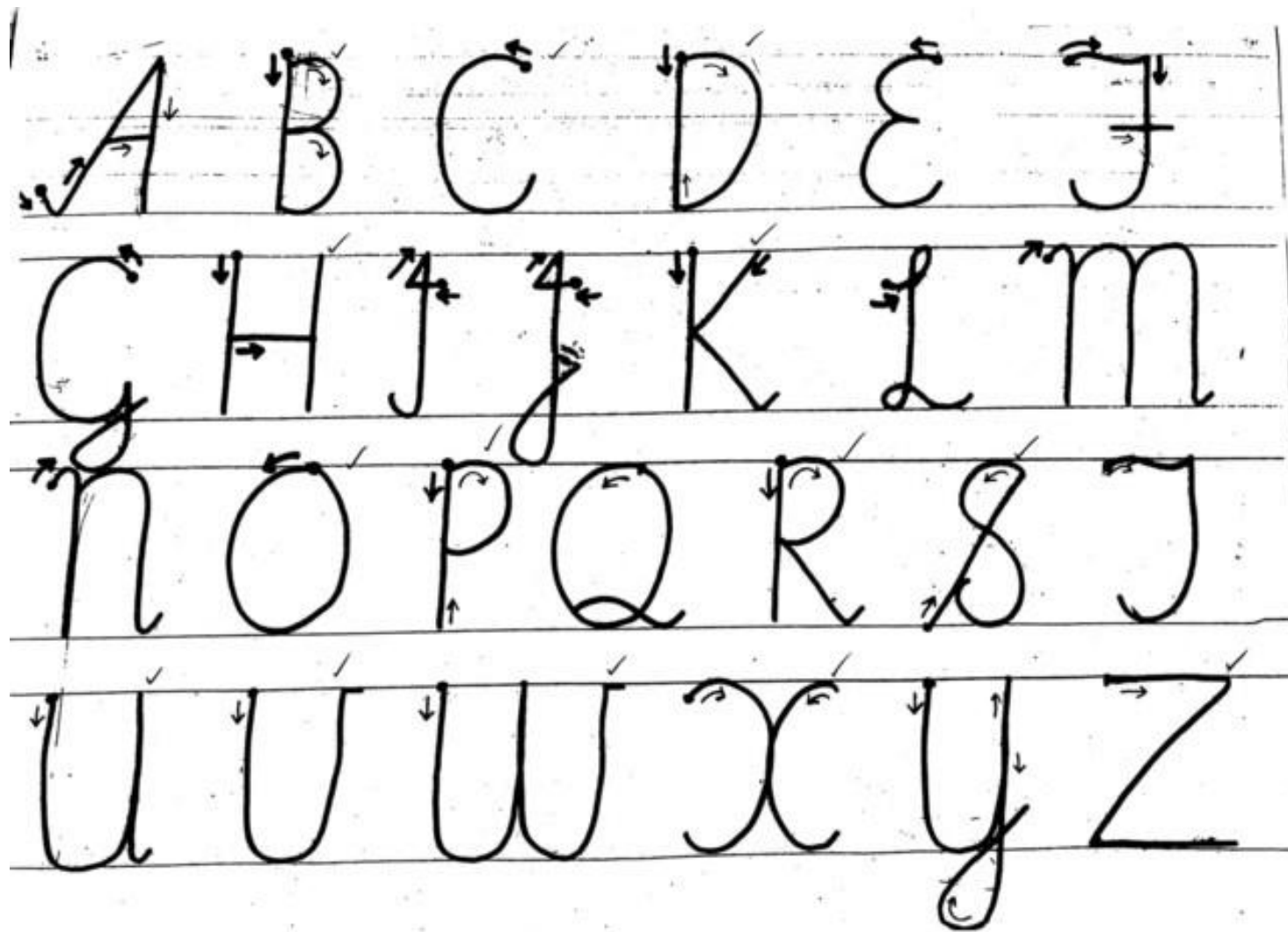

<p>Aim: To write, say and identify capital letters.</p> <p>Please use the Windyknowe uppercase letter formation worksheet in your pack to help. A copy of this can also be found below.</p> <p>Have a go at writing these capital letters. Adults may wish to dictate the words beside each letter below. Use a lined page to practise positioning them correctly on the lines.</p> <p>I – Start at the top of the line and draw a short, straight line across, slope up and then go straight down to the bottom with a small curve.</p> <p>J – Start at the top of the line and draw a short, straight line across, slope up and then go straight down like the I but continue the same line down below the line and curve it around under the paper line like the Y and the G.</p> <p><u>Extra challenge</u> – Can you invent a superhero name that begins with today’s capital letters? What would they look like and what would be their special power?</p>	<p>Aim: To read for information.</p> <p>Have a go at reading the following. Ask an adult to read it with you if you need some help. The text is on the next page in a larger font.</p> <p>‘Minibeasts have different ways of gathering food.
