<p>Aim: To listen carefully for information</p> <p>Here is a game to practise your prepositions knowledge!</p> <p>Ask a family member to give you a one part instruction for you to follow e.g.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• sit under the table</li> <li>• lie on the floor</li> <li>• walk between the chairs</li> </ul> <p>Now try listening for two part instructions such as</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• lie on the floor and clap your hands</li> <li>• sit on a chair and stamp your feet</li> </ul> <p>Now try some three part instructions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sit on a chair, look at the ceiling and clap your hands.</li> <li>• Lie on the floor, lift a leg and wave your hand.</li> </ul> <p><u>Extra challenge:</u> Can you make up your own two or three part instructions?</p>
