Today we are going to learn how to do an art technique called Zentangle.

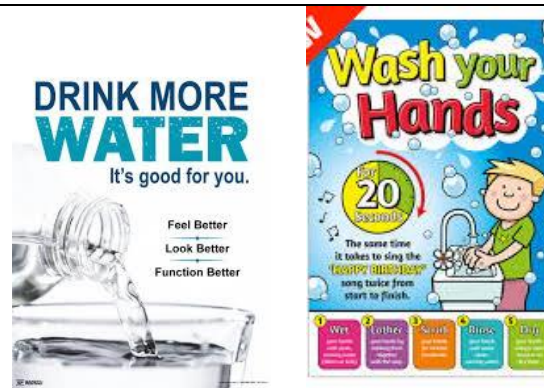
People that practicing **Zentangle** have found that it has increased self-confidence, relieved stress and anxiety, improved eye-hand coordination and nurtured/ developed creativity.

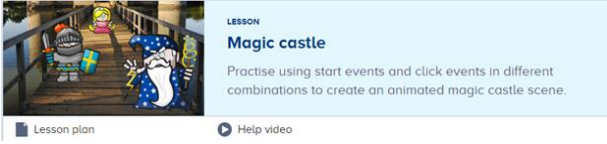
and ask an adult to draw around your hand.
