




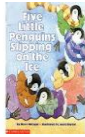

Can you discuss texture, colour and size of trees? Collect sticks and Foliage. To bring home. How man sticks do you think you will need to collect to create a stick man? (Write down your thoughts before going for a walk). Can you explore making your own story while you walk. Part 2: Create your own stickman. Use the items from your walk or around the house to create your own stick family. (Keep some foliage for science activity).
